

# Self-Guided Bicycle Tour Seaside Promenade

*Be safe, cross busy streets at stop lights and watch for cars.*



1	Exit Wheel Fun Rentals and turn <b>left</b> onto <b>Avenue A</b> .
2	Turn <b>right</b> onto the <b>Promenade</b> .
3	Turn <b>right</b> onto <b>12th Ave</b> .
4	Turn <b>right</b> onto <b>Necanicum Dr</b> , free ride around Goodman Park & Necanicum River
5	Return to <b>12th Ave</b> and turn <b>right</b> .
6	Turn <b>left</b> onto <b>Holladay Dr</b> . to view <b>Necanicum Estuary Park</b> across from Seaside High School just past 17th St.

7	Return to <b>12th Ave</b> and turn <b>left</b> .
8	Turn <b>right</b> onto <b>Wahanna Rd</b> .
9	<b>OPTIONAL:</b> (moderate to difficult incline) - Turn <b>left</b> on <b>Broadway St</b> . Go to the top of the hill and enjoy the scenic view. Head back down and <b>proceed on Broadway St</b> .
10	<b>IF YOU DO NOT WANT TO TAKE OPTIONAL PATH:</b> turn <b>right</b> onto <b>Broadway St</b> .
11	Continue to follow <b>Broadway St</b> , turn <b>left</b> onto <b>S. Columbia St</b> .
12	Turn <b>right</b> onto <b>Avenue A</b> .
13	Turn <b>left</b> onto the <b>Promenade</b> .
14	Turn <b>left</b> onto <b>Avenue U</b> .
15	Turn <b>right</b> onto <b>Beach Dr</b> .
16	Stay to the <b>right</b> of fork, merging onto <b>Ocean Vista Dr</b> .
17	Continue to follow <b>Ocean Vista Dr</b> .
18	<b>Ocean Vista Dr</b> . becomes <b>Sunset Blvd</b> , follow to the end of the street.
19	Explore <b>Tillamook Head</b> , and <b>return back</b> along <b>Sunset Blvd</b> . the way you came. While exploring lock your bikes.
20	<b>Sunset Blvd</b> becomes <b>Ocean Vista Dr</b> .
21	Stay to the <b>left</b> of fork, continuing on <b>Ocean Vista Dr</b> .
22	Turn <b>left</b> onto <b>Beach Dr</b> .
23	Turn <b>left</b> onto <b>Avenue U</b> .
24	Turn <b>right</b> onto <b>S. Promenade</b> .
25	Turn <b>right</b> onto <b>Avenue A</b> , returning to <b>Wheel Fun Rentals</b> . We hope you enjoyed your tour!

## A Lewis & Clark Trail and Statue

The Turnaround at Seaside, Oregon, is designed as the official end of the Lewis and Clark Trail. In 1990, a bronze statue of Meriwether Lewis, William Clark and Seaman, was installed facing the ocean at the west end of Broadway at the Turnaround on the center of the Promenade.



## B Seaside Promenade

The only one of its kind on the Oregon coast, the Seaside Promenade is an 8,000-foot long concrete boardwalk between central Seaside and its spectacular beach.



## C Seaside Aquarium

This coastal aquarium is home to many sea creatures from octopus to sharks and eels. There is a petting tank where, if you dare, you can touch rigid starfish among other ocean attractions.



## D Goodman Park

This park has restrooms, basketball hoops, and swings. It is also located right next to the 12th Avenue Bridge, where locals and visitors alike often congregate.

## F Necanicum Estuary Park - Wildlife Viewing

The Necanicum Estuary (where the river meets the ocean) is a diverse natural habitat and a great place to explore.



## E Seaside Historical Society Museum - Butterfield Cottage

Learn the history of Oregon's first seaside resort. Exhibits detail over 2,000 years of Seaside heritage, artifacts dating from 700 B.C. and a diorama depicting Seaside in 1899.



## G Seaside Visitors Bureau

This is an excellent venue to help find various local interests. Brochures and detailed information for taking small trips throughout the surrounding area are available free of charge.



## H Gilbert District & Seaside Antique Mall

Features more than a dozen shops filled with fashion, antiques, art and fine restaurants.



## J Seaside Carousel Mall

Twenty unique shops surround a full-size working carousel. The mall offers dining, snacks, coffee, specialty gifts, art, imports and more.



## I Quatat Park

This park, home to our Wheel Fun Rentals boat location, has a boat ramp, picnic tables, river viewing decks, fishing dock, deck seating with a stage area, and restrooms.



## K Cottages from Early 1900's

The cottages were a great place for the Portlandites to spend some quality time at Seaside Oregon was known as the end of the railroad line in the early 1900's.



## L Tillamook Rock Lighthouse

The Tillamook Rock Lighthouse was completed in 1881 to guide ships approaching the Columbia River past the dangerous jutting headland.



## M Salt Works

The Salt Works marks the site where the Lewis and Clark expedition set up a camp and boiled seawater to obtain salt for use at Fort Clatsop and on the return journey to St. Louis.



## N Surfers Cove

Rain or shine, the Seaside Cove is a must-see-stop whether you're a tourist or a local. It's a mixture of sandy and rocky beach, and the point break makes it a surfer's haven.



## O Tillamook Head

Tillamook Head is a tilted remnant of a massive, 15-million-year-old Columbia River basalt flow. Incredibly, the lava welled up near Idaho, flooded down the Columbia Gorge, and spread along the seashore to this point.
